Request:

Request Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to extend the completion timeframe to December 31, 2016 for Town Branch Trail Crossing at Old Frankfort Pike and McConnell Springs Drive under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program

Purpose of Request:

On May 7, 2015 (Resolution 264-2015), Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$43,000 under the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program for design of a crossing that will provide a safe, at-grade crossing of Old Frankfort Pike at McConnell Springs Drive.

On July 7, 2015 (Resolution 448-2015), Council approved amendment accepting additional federal funding for design in the amount of \$22,200 for a total design amount of \$65,200.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG an additional allotment of time for completion and has requested that the contract be extended until December 31, 2016.
