Authorization to accept a grant from the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice, which grant funds are in the amount of \$20,000 federal funds, under the Title II Program, to operate the "No Limit to Success Program" in the Division of Youth Services. Local match in the amount of \$5,040 will be provided through in-kind personnel. Budget Amendment is in process. (L0787-17) (Hong/Ford)

Authorization to execute a Purchase of Service Agreement with Hope Center for Detention Center Recovery Program to provide daily recovery services to the inmates of the Fayette County Detention Center. Total cost of contract is \$173,000. Funds are budgeted. (L0897-17) (Haney/Bastin)

f	<u>0912-17</u>	Authorization to execute the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Program Funded State & Local Task Force agreement. The terms of the agreement shall be from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018. This agreement allows for two (2) Detectives assigned to the DEA State & Local Task Force positions, within the Lexington Police Department, to be assigned as Program Funded State & Local Task Force positions. There will be no budgetary impact. (L0912-17) (Barnard/Bastin)
g	<u>0913-17</u>	Authorization to execute the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Tactical Diversion Squad Agreement. The term of this agreement shall be from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018. The Tactical Diversion Squad Agreement allows for one (1) Lexington Police Department Officer to be assigned to the Tactical Diversion Squad for a period of not less than two years. There will be no budgetary impact. (L0913-17) (Barnard/Bastin)
h	<u>0917-17</u>	Authorization to accept award from the Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management of federal funds in the amount of \$496,250 under the Fiscal Year 2017 Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP). Budget Amendment is in process. (L0917-17) (Dugger/Bastin)

i	0922-17	Authorization to execute a Sole Source Agreement between LFUCG and Routeware, Inc. for the purchase of hardware and database maintenance at a cost of \$39,586.80 required as part of the government-wide GPS program for its fleet. Funds are budgeted. (L0922-17) (Martin/Hoskins-Squier)

m	<u>0933-17</u>	Authorization to execute Amendment to the Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Program extending the period of performance through June 30, 2018 for the West Loudon Avenue Streetscape Project. No change to the budget. (L0933-17) (Burton/Paulsen)
n	<u>0934-17</u>	Authorization to execute Amendment No. 3 to Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet accepting additional federal funding in the amount of \$75,000 for the Right of Way (ROW) phase for the Phase IV of the Town Branch Trail Project. The 20% required local match for design will be provided by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet through toll credits. This match is valued at \$15,000. Budget Amendment is in process.
