SUBJECT: Agreement with Windstream Communications – Increase to Telephone Circuit Bandwidth

Request:

A resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign a 12-month agreement with Windstream Communications, which increases an existing Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS) telephone circuit at the 911 Center at 150 E. Main Street from 1.5M to 3.0M.

Why are you requesting?

The existing 1.5M MPLS circuit connects Lexington Enhanced 911 telephone traffic to 24 counties in the Central Kentucky 911 Network. During the month of August, Lexington 911 will install a new 911 telephone system in both the Public Safety Operations Center and the Back-up 911 Center, which will require more bandwidth at the Back-up 911 Center in order to handle traffic on the new system.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?

Yes. The monthly cost is \$561, which is a \$145.90 monthly increase. The FY17 budget will cover the expense.

Are the funds budgeted?
