Dear Landowner:

The United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is conducting a remedial investigation for groundwater contamination at the Lexington Bluegrass Army Depot. We request your permission to gain access to your property for a period of 24 months beginning at the signing of this instrument to determine if groundwater contamination is present. This will involve collecting water samples from hydrogeologic features (springs, seeps, streams, etc.) and placing inert carbon packets for a Dye Tracer Study. A partnership between the USACE and yourself is needed for the successful outcome of the project and gaining access to your property is essential.
