AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN OF THE BUDGETS OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO REFLECT CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR MUNICIPAL EXPENDITURES, AND APPROPRIATING AND RE-APPROPRIATING FUNDS, SCHEDULE NO. 0027.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for municipal expenditures, and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:

-) \$_1,088,672.50_ _from_ the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the General Services District Fund _to_various accounts.
 -) \$_444.00_ _from_ the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Donation Fund _to_ various accounts.
-) \$_246,198.98_ _from_ the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Full Urban Services District Fund _to_ various accounts.
-) \$_115,000.00_ _from_ the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Police Confiscated Federal Fund _to_ various accounts.
-) \$_2, 367.00_ _from_ the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Sanitary Sewer Fund _to_ various accounts.
-) \$_179,363.56_ _from_ the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Water Quality Management Fund _to_ various accounts.
-) Re-appropriations within the General Services District Fund; 2015 Bond Projects; Refunding GO Bond 2015A; 2017 Bond Projects Fund; Sanitary Sewer Construction Fund; Water Quality Construction Fund; and the various grant funds which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds.
- Section 2 That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "BUDGET SCHEDULE NO. 0027" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
 - Section 3 That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
