A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THAT THE TRIBUTARY FLOWING THROUGH THE DOGWOOD TRACE SUBDIVISION IN LEXINGTON-FAYETTE COUNTY IS NAMED "BRANNON RUN" FROM THE POINT OF ITS ORIGIN TO THE POINT OF ITS

CONFLUENCE WITH SOUTH ELKHORN CREEK.

WHEREAS, headwater streams play a critical role in the ecology, the hydrology,

and the quality of water of larger streams and rivers, by providing sediment control,

nutrient control, reducing downstream flooding, providing wildlife habitat, and

maintaining base flow in larger streams and rivers; and

WHEREAS, Neighbors United for South Elkhorn Creek is currently working to

restore the natural vegetative stream buffers along the stream that flows through the

Dogwood Trace subdivision and enters South Elkhorn Creek; and

WHEREAS, this stream that flows through the Dogwood Trace subdivision is an

important aesthetic and environmental amenity; and

WHEREAS, volunteers working with Neighbors United for South Elkhorn Creek

have been using the name "Brannon Run" to refer to this stream during their work; and

WHEREAS, Neighbors United for South Elkhorn Creek has petitioned the

Lexington Fayette Urban County Council to recognize "Brannon Run" as the name of

this stream from the point of its origin to the point of its confluence with South Elkhorn

Creek.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE

LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 – That the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government

recognizes that the tributary flowing through the Dogwood Trace subdivision located in

Lexington-Fayette County is named "Brannon Run" from the point of its origin to the

point of its confluence with South Elkhorn Creek.

Section 2 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its

passage.
