SUBJECT: Seagrave Agreement

The Division of Fire and Emergency Services request authorization to enter into a contract agreement with Seagrave Fire Apparatus, LLC for the purchase of 1 new rural-specific pumper apparatus at the cost of \$1,213,010.00. Seagrave is on the HGAC cooperative agreement.

Why are you requesting? To replace an aging and high-mileage pumper. A rural pumper fire truck is a specialized fire truck designed for use in rural areas. These trucks are equipped with a water pump, a water tank, and other necessary firefighting equipment to respond to fires in areas with limited access to public water sources like fire hydrants.

Department needs this action completed because: The unit scheduled for replacement will then be assigned to the division's reserve fleet, refurbished, or replaced with older units currently in the reserve fleet.

Circumstances under which the contract between Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, Lexington, Kentucky and Seagrave Fire Apparatus, LLC ("Contract") may be terminated. The following language reflects our position on the issue of contract termination. 1. For cause: a. Breach of Contract, which would include, but is not limited to the following occurrences: i. One party fails to fulfill their obligations under the terms of the Contract and, after receiving notice, is unable to remediate the situation in a reasonable amount of time. ii. The actions of one party cause the other party to be unable to perform their obligations under the terms of the Contract. b. Termination for Impossibility of Performance if it is deemed impossible for a party to perform the required obligations of the Contract. 2. By Mutual Agreement between the parties to terminate the Contract.
