SUBJECT:

Request Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet extending performance period of South Limestone Streetscape Project through September 30,

2015

On April 28, 2011 (Ordinance No. 51-2011), Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$750,000 for the installation of streetscape amenities on South Limestone from Vine Street to Avenue of Champions and on Vine Street from Broadway to Limestone. Amenities include intersection, ADA, and bicycle mobility improvements, transit shelter, site fixtures and furnishings, bicycle facilities, and signage.

On April 24, 2014(Resolution No. 185-2014) Council authorized execution of an Amendment to the Agreement extending the performance period through June 30, 2015.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG an amendment providing for an extended performance period through September 30, 2015. No other changes are proposed.

Council authorization to execute the Amendment to Agreement is hereby requested.
