SUBJECT: Accept American Rescue Plan Act Funds from the Kentucky Cabinet for

Health and Family Services, Department for Community Based Services for

the Extended School Program

Request: Council authorization to accept award of federal funds from the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Department for Community Based Services in the amount of \$216,382.16 under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to support child care expenses for the Extended School Program in the Division of Parks & Recreation. No matching funds required.

Purpose of Request: The Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Department of Community Based Services has granted the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Extended School Program in the Division of Parks & Recreation federal funds in the amount of \$216,382.16 to support child care expenses and personnel costs.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Federal funding of \$216,382.16. No match is required. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment 11617 is in process.
