**SUBJECT:** Agreement with Information Station Specialists, Inc. for StreamCast Service

**Request**

Request Council authorization to execute agreement in the amount of \$359.40 with Information Station Specialists, Inc. for 12 months of HearMoreInfo StreamCast Service for the Division of Emergency Management/911

**Why are you requesting?**

On May 26, 2016, (Resolution 318-2016), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management for the continued operation of the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP). CSEPP funds are used to support emergency preparedness activities for the ten county area that surrounds the Blue Grass Army Depot in Richmond, the site of a stockpile of chemical weapons.

An approved activity is the use of funds to support a streaming service for the broadcast of public service announcements over the Public Safety AM Radio (1620).

**What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years?**

Current year costs in the amount of \$359.40 are budgeted through September 30, 2017. It is anticipated that grant funds will be available for these services in future budget years.
