

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO  
CONTRACT FOR SERVICES**

**THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES**, made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2026, (the “Effective Date”) by and between the **LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT (“LFUCG”)**, on behalf of its Division of Environmental Services, and the **Kentucky Association for Environmental Education (“KAEE”)** of Elizabethtown, Kentucky, (collectively known as the “Parties”).

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the Parties entered into a Contract approved pursuant to R-395-2024 (the “Contract”) to provide environmental education services;

**WHEREAS**, the Parties seek to expand transportation education to enhance community awareness, and meet the increasing demand for environmental education services;

**WHEREAS**, additional transportation funds will support expanded lessons, an updated approach to the elementary grade units of sturdy, and additional emphasis on the Safe Routes to School efforts;

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to amend the Contract to include additional services and compensation as outlined herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties hereby agree to amend the above-referenced term and total payment amount in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Amendment.

**STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

- 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS.** The above recitals and referenced exhibits are incorporated herein as part of this Amendment.
- 2. SCOPE OF SERVICES.** In addition to the services required under the original Contract and Amendments 1 and 2, KAEE shall provide the additional services described in Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. These additional services include:
  - a. Expanded Environmental Education Services.** KAEE will support and promote the city’s transportation efforts while meeting academic standards, including out-of-school-time education, and will promote Safe Routes to School efforts. Funds will cover educator time, transportation, supplies, and field experience expenses.

3. **COMPENSATION.** For the additional services described in Exhibit 1, LFUCG agrees to pay KAEE an additional amount of **Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00)**, bringing the annual contract amount to \$688,636.27.
4. **EFFECT.** All other provisions of the Contract, which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

## **Exhibit 1**

### **Amendment to the Environmental Education Services Scope of Work**

Agreement with Kentucky Association for Environmental Education - Resolution R-395-2024

In addition to the services required under the original Contract and the Contract as subsequently amended, KAEE shall provide these additional services.

#### Additional Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Funding

The addition of the \$40,000 in MPO funding will enable the education team to expand its current transportation-related offerings. This expansion will give additional funding for

- increased out-of-school time programming focused on transportation and bike/walk outreach during afterschool hours, fall break, spring break, and summer vacation; and
- time and materials used to maintain the fleet of 30 bicycles, balance bikes, and scooters.

It is anticipated that these funds will result in about a 50% increase in the number of transportation-related student interactions per year, from ~4,000 to ~6,000.
