Bids to establish a price contract for HVACR Maintenance and Repair for Community Corrections for the Division of Community Corrections were received in the Division of Central Purchasing on March 13, 2013.

Economic Engine notified two hundred ninety-five (295) vendors with fifty-nine (59) vendors viewing the document. Five (5) bids were received.

Thermal Equipment Sales Inc submitted the lowest bid on Schedules A and C but withdrew their bid.

TP Mechanical Contractors submitted the second lowest bid on Schedule A and Alliance Comfort Systems Inc submitted the second lowest bid on Schedule C.

The bids of TP Mechanical Contractors for Schedule A and Alliance Comfort Systems Inc for Schedule C meet bid specifications and are within budgetary constraints, therefore, the bids of TP Mechanical Contractors for Schedule A and Alliance Comfort Systems Inc for Schedule C are recommended.
