

## **Corridors Commission Membership Amendment**

For the 10.23.12 Work Session

At the September 18 Corridors Commission Councilmember Beard suggested that the Commissioner of Planning, Preservation & Development or his designee be added to the Corridors Commission as a non voting member. This is consistent with several commissioners that sit on Corridors as non voting members. Councilmember Beard felt, and I agree that this appointment would improve communications and foster a better relationship and make Corridors more meaningful.

Law subsequently drafted such an amendment and it was voted and approved unanimously by the Commission at its Oct 16 meeting.

**Therefore on behalf of the Corridors Commission “I move to place on the docket at the October 25<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting under 1<sup>st</sup> reading of ordinances, an ordinance to amend section 2-465 of the Code to add the office of the Commissioner of Planning, Preservation or his designee as non voting members to the Corridors Commission.”**
