53 Miles


Missing Sidewalks on Both Sides

Project Types

- Major Local Projects
 - Significant design and planning required.
 - Likely involve right-of-way acquisition and/or utility relocation.
 - Potentially funded by grants or local capital funding.

Local Projects

- Design and planning is typically less complex.
- Typically do not involve right-of-way acquisition or utility relocation.
- Funded with local dollars.



Major Local Project Example

- Southland Drive
 - 1.1 miles of sidewalks along both sides of Southland Drive.
 - Design funding of \$250,000 in FY 2016
 - Construction funding of \$1,850,000 in FY 2017 MPB.





Local Project Example

- Harrodsburg Road
 - 800 ft of sidewalk on Harrodsburg Road.
 - Design to be done in-house.
 - Construction cost estimate of \$71,702.50.





Sidewalk Ranking Criteria Development

- Criteria aims to prioritize projects in locations with:
 - high-pedestrian activity
 - documented pedestrian collisions
 - nearby destinations
 - on or near transit
 - demographic indicators of need
 - potential for connectivity
- Criteria based on 2007 Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan.
- Transportation Planning and GIS completed the analysis.
- Criteria includes 14 elements.



Missing Sidewalk Ranking Criteria

- Connectivity at Each End
- Housing Density

- Walk to Work in Area
- Bike to Work in Area
- Transit to Work in Area
- Speed Limit

- Pedestrian Collisions
 - Midblock
 - Intersection
- Project Impact



Missing Sidewalk Ranking Criteria

- Bus Stops
 - Within ¼ Mile
 - Between ¼ ½ Mile
- Households in Poverty
- Vehicle Availability

- Employees
 - Within ¼ Mile
 - Between ½ ½ Mile
- Businesses
 - Within ¼ Mile
 - Between ¼ ½ Mile
- Community Destinations
 - Within ¼ Mile
 - Between ½ ½ Mile



- Ranking criteria establishes need; request system establishes project support.
- System allows submittal of projects, status tracking, as well as voting.
- Will serve as a central, transparent repository of sidewalk requests.


