



Re: Request for Authorization to Enter into an Assistance Agreement by and between Kentucky Infrastructure Authority and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for a Low-Interest (2%) Loan Related to the Wolf Run Pump Station Relocation and Expansion Project

The purpose of this memorandum is to request authorization to enter into an Assistance Agreement by and between Kentucky Infrastructure Authority and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government. This agreement will allow the LFUCG to accept a low-interest (2%) loan through the Federally Assisted Wastewater Revolving Loan Fund Program, Fund A in the amount of \$10,500,000.00 related to the Wolf Run Pump Station Relocation and Expansion Project.

Application was made after receiving authorization from the Urban County Council via Resolution 80-2008.
