

DEED OF EASEMENT

This **PERMANENT SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT** is made and entered into this the 24th day of February, 2021, by and between **PATRICK WAYNE POYNTER, a single person**, 3685 Niles Drive, Lexington, Kentucky 40517, which is the in-care of tax mailing address for the current year (hereinafter "Grantor"), and **LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT**, 200 East Main Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507, (hereinafter "Grantee").

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of **TWO HUNDRED NINETY-NINE DOLLARS AND 88/100 DOLLARS (\$299.88)**, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantor has **BARGAINED** and **SOLD** and does hereby **GIVE, GRANT** and **CONVEY** unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, permanent right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of sanitary sewer improvements and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on the attached Exhibit "A", and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

(a portion of 3685 Niles Drive)

All that strip or parcel of land situated on the south side of Niles Drive west of Crosby Drive in Lexington, Fayette

County, Kentucky, and being more fully described and bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the southerly right of way line of Niles Drive, said point being a common corner between Lots 21 and 22, Block " A", as shown on the Amended Record Plat of Melody Village Subdivision, Unit One (Cabinet B, Slide 90);

Thence leaving the southerly right of way line of Niles Drive and with the easterly property line of Lot 21, S 22° 53' 42" W, 146.72 feet to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence leaving the easterly property line of Lot 21, and with a new permanent sanitary sewer easement line through the lands of Lot 22 for two (2) calls:

- 1.) S 83° 37' 44" E, 39.55 feet to a point; and
- 2.) S 81° 32' 10" E, 22.80 feet to a point in the westerly property line of Lot 23;

Thence continuing with the westerly property line of Lot 23, S 22° 53' 42" W, 14.39 feet to a point;

Thence leaving the westerly property line of Lot 23, and with an existing 40-foot Sanitary, Storm, and Utility Easement line through the lands of Lot 22, N 83° 06' 18" W, 62.42 feet to a point in the easterly property line of the aforesaid Lot 21;

Thence continuing with the easterly property line of Lot 21, N 22° 53' 42" E, 14.67 feet to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**; and,

The above-described parcel contains 888 square feet (0.020 Acres) of permanent easement; and

Being a portion of the property conveyed to Patrick Wayne Poynter, a single person, by Deed dated January 31, 2011, of record in Deed Book 2994, Page 25, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office.

FURTHER, for and in consideration of the sum hereinbefore mentioned, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor has **BARGAINED** and **SOLD** and does hereby **GIVE, GRANT** and **CONVEY** unto the Grantee, its successors

and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of sanitary sewer placement and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and more particularly described as follows:

Temporary Construction Easement
Southeastern Hills Trunk Sewer Improvement Project
(a portion of 3685 Niles Drive)

All that strip or parcel of land situated on the south side of Niles Drive west of Crosby Drive in Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, and being more fully described and bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the southerly right of way line of Niles Drive, said point being a common corner between Lots 21 and 22, Block "A", as shown on the Amended Record Plat of Melody Village Subdivision, Unit One (Cabinet B, Slide 90);

Thence leaving the southerly right of way line of Niles Drive and with the easterly property line of Lot 21, S 22° 53' 42" W, 136.29 feet to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence leaving the easterly property line of Lot 21 and with a new temporary construction easement line through the lands of Lot 22 for two (2) calls:

- 1.) S 83° 37' 44" E, 36.77 feet to a point; and
- 2.) S 81° 32' 10" E, 25.56 feet to a point in the westerly property line of Lot 23;

Thence continuing with the westerly property line of Lot 23, S 22° 53' 42" W, 10.33 feet to a point;

Thence leaving the westerly property line of Lot 23, and with a new permanent sanitary sewer easement line through the lands of Lot 22 for two (2) calls:

- 1.) N 81° 32' 10" W, 22.80 feet to a point; and

2.) N 83° 37' 44" W, 39.55 feet to a point in the easterly property line of the aforesaid Lot 21;

Thence continuing with the easterly property line of Lot 21, N 22° 53' 42" E, 10.43 feet to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**; and,

The above-described parcel contains a total area of 623 square feet (0.014 Acres) of temporary construction easement;

Being a portion of the property conveyed to Patrick Wayne Poynter, a single person, by Deed dated January 31, 2011, of record in Deed Book 2994, Page 25, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above-described easements together with all rights, appurtenances, and improvements thereunto belonging unto Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easement runs with the land for the duration of the improvement project and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantor. The above-described permanent easement runs with the land in perpetuity and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantor. The temporary construction easement shall take effect upon the commencement of construction of the project and will expire upon completion of the project.

Grantor shall have the full right to use the surface of the land lying over said permanent easement for any purpose desired, provided such use will not interfere with the Grantee's free use of the easement herein granted and provided further that no building or structure shall be erected upon, across, over or through said permanent easement without prior written consent of the Grantee.

Grantor does hereby release and relinquish unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, all of his right, title, and interest in and to the property to the extent of the interests conveyed herein, including all exemptions allowed by law, and do hereby covenant to and with the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that he is lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and has good right to sell and convey the easements as herein done, and that he will **WARRANT GENERALLY** said title.

The obtaining of this easement was authorized by Resolution 456-2020, passed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on October 8, 2020. Pursuant to KRS 382.135(2)(a), this deed of easement, which pertains to a public utility, need not contain a statement of consideration.
