Second Annual Renewal of Sanitary Sewer Monitoring and Alarm Equipment Services (R-427-2023)

Request

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) requests authorization to utilize the second annual renewal (R-427-2023) of the professional services contract with ADS Environmental Services (ADS, LLC), the division's sole source provider for sewer overflow monitoring/reporting services related to the existing monitoring system located at 22 strategic locations within the service area.

Purpose of Request

The continued flow monitor, operation/maintenance services, cell service, and web hosting operations of the current contract are essential for the future use of the existing monitoring system, as required by the CMOM (Compliance, Management, Operations, and Maintenance) component of the Consent Decree obligations.

Project Cost in FY25 and Future Budget Years

Contract #149-2022 provides for up to 12 months as part of the second annual renewal, 22 monitors, for a yearly fee of \$83,832.
