Division of Forestry of federal funds in the amount of \$10,000 for

treatment of ash trees on public land

The Kentucky Division of Forestry has offered the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government an award of federal funds in the amount of \$10,000 for the treatment of ash trees on publicly-managed land. Ash trees shall be treated with an insecticide for the prevention of damage and/or recovery from damage by the emerald ash borer. Public education about the emerald ash borer will also be incorporated into the project. No matching funds are required.

These federal funds originate from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Services, Forest Health Program Funds.
