As agreed to by the parties, this document modifies the Agreement dated October 1, 2016, between the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government. The DEA is authorized to enter into this cooperative agreement concerning the use and abuse of controlled substances under the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 873.

MODIFICATION:




