## Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request authorization to execute an agreement awarding a Class B (Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant to Opportunity for Work & Learning, Inc. (OWL) for a Feasibility Study improving water quality, at a total cost not to exceed \$15,000.00.

# Purpose of Request

This grant is for a Feasibility Study to evaluate opportunities to implement stormwater Best Management Practices (BMPs) for six properties at Kennedy Road in the Cane Run Watershed. The projects purpose is to improve water quality in the Cane Run watershed by filtering the stormwater water quality volume (WQV) from the building parking lots, roads, and other urbanized impervious areas.

### Project Cost in FY16 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$15,000.00 and is anticipated to be fully spent by FY17.
