SUBJECT: Substance Abuse Program at the Division of Community Corrections

Request:

Council authorization to execute agreement with Shepherd's House for the provision of substance abuse programing for women in the amount of \$65,700 for FY 2020.

Purpose of Request:

On July 9, 2019 (Resolution 404-2019), Council authorized the acceptance of state funding from the Kentucky Department of Corrections/Adult Institutions Division of Substance Abuse in the amount of \$65,700 for operation of a 20-bed Substance Abuse Recovery Program for females at the Fayette County Detention Center for FY20.

A Request for Proposals (RFP-#16-2019) was issued on April 10, 2019 soliciting proposals from interested firms who are qualified substance abuse treatment providers to provide a substance abuse treatment (SAP) program that would operate within the Fayette County Detention Center for female state offenders. Of the proposals received, Shepherd's House was determined to be superior with regard to selection criteria. The contract is a 3-year contract expiring on August 31, 2022 and includes a provision for three automatic one-year renewals.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Available funds in Fiscal Year 2020 is \$65,700 and will be used to contract with Shepherd's House, a substance abuse programming provider. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.
