SUBJECT: Police Training Incentive for Fiscal Year 2018

Request:

Council authorization to accept award for Police Training Incentive Grant in an amount up to \$3,145,440 for FY 2018 from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet under the Kentucky Law Enforcement Foundation Program Fund

Purpose of Request:

Police Training Incentive funds are used to provide eligible police officers with supplemental pay for participation in training programs. Supplemental pay in the amount of \$4,000 for each eligible officer (600 sworn positions) is provided for a total of \$2,400,000. In addition, the program contributes up to 31.06% of that total towards the pension of participants, totaling \$745,440.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Grant funds for Fiscal Year 2018 total \$3,145,440 with no local match required. Future years' funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

Are the funds budgeted?

Budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2018 is in process.
