HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM

On December 1, 2011 (Resolution No. 548-2011), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for the purchase of Special Operations, Hazardous Materials and Technical Rescue Equipment for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services.

On February 23, 2012 (Resolution No. 92-2012), Council approved Thermo Fisher Scientific as a sole source provider of equipment: for the Special Operations Unit in the Division of Fire and Emergency Services.

Ahura Scientific is the correct name of the vendor for this equipment.
