SUBJECT: Purchase of Services Agreement for \$451,710 with Lexington-Fayette Urban

County Human Rights Commission

Request: Council authorization to execute a Purchase of Service Agreement for \$451,710 with Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission for FY 2026.

Purpose of Request: The FY 2026 General Fund Budget provides \$451,7100 to support the operating costs of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission. The agency will continue to safeguard all individuals within Lexington-Fayette County from discrimination based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, disability, familial status, and sexual orientation/gender identity in connection with housing, employment, and public accommodations and to effect the provisions and purposes of the Kentucky Civil Rights Act (KRS Chapter 3444), Urban County Ordinances 199-94 and 201-99, provision 7.17 of the Lexington-Fayette Merger Charter of 1974, and any other laws enacted by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government relating to the Commission.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Available funding in Fiscal Year 2026 is \$451,710

Are the funds budgeted? Yes, funds are in the mayor's proposed FY2026 Budget.
