**Request:**

Council authorization to execute a Purchase of Service of Agreement in the amount of \$205,725 with Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission for FY 2020.

**Purpose of Request:**

The FY 2020 General Fund Budget provides for \$205,725 to support the operating costs of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission. The agency will continue to safeguard all individuals within Lexington-Fayette County from discrimination based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, disability, familial status and sexual orientation/gender identity in connection with housing, employment and public accommodations and to effect the provisions and purposes of the Kentucky Civil Rights Act (KRS Chapter 3444), Urban County Ordinances 199-94 and 201-99, provision 7.17 of the Lexington-Fayette Merger Charter of 1974, and any other laws enacted by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government relating to the Commission.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?**

Available funding in Fiscal Year 2020 is \$205,725

**Are the funds budgeted?**

Yes, funds are in the FY2020 Budget.
