**SUBJECT: Sole Source Provider Emergent formerly Adapt Pharma for Division of Social Services**

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**Request:** Council authorization to establish Emergent formerly Adapt Pharma as a sole source provider of nasal Narcan for the SAMSHA FY2022 First-Responders-Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Support Services Act Extended First Responders and Community Partners Overdose Prevention Project for the Division of Social Services at a cost not to exceed \$12,540.

**Why are you requesting?** On September 8, 2022 (Resolution No. 485-2022) Council authorized the acceptance of \$499,997 in federal grant funds from the United States Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration under the FY2022 First Responders-Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Support Services Act for increased collaboration with community stakeholders in an effort to reduce overdose fatalities. This grant provides funding for the purchase of naloxone to serve the grant's primary objective of reducing overdose deaths in Lexington, Fayette County.

**What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years?** \$12,540 cost in FY24 through September 30, 2023. Subsequent Year 2 grant funds are budgeted at \$66,880, upon Year 2 approval by SAMHSA in FY24 and FY25.
