CORRECTIONS

On May 2, 2013 (Resolution No. 205-2013), Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$44,314 with the National Council on Crime and Delinquency under a cooperative agreement with the Bureau of Justice Assistance under the Establish "Zero Tolerance" Cultures for Sexual Abuse in Local Adult and Juvenile Detention Facilities grant program. Expiration date of project is March 31, 2014.

The National Council on Crime and Delinquency has offered the LFUCG Amendment #1 extending the period of performance through September 30, 2014. The amendment provides for no other changes.
