Management extending performance period for a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program grant for Southbend-Lone Oak Drive-Lafayette

Parkway Area

On December 9, 2010 (Ordinance 212-2010), Council approved the acceptance of federal funds from the Department Of Military Affairs/Kentucky Division of Emergency Management under the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the implementation of a flood hazard mitigation project. This project included the purchase and demolition of nine residential properties on Lone Oak Drive, Southbend Drive, and Lafayette Parkway. This project expires on June 30, 2012. The Kentucky Division of Emergency Management has offered the LFUCG an agreement extending the performance period of the project through September 14, 2012. No other changes are proposed.
