**Request:**

Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with Sunflower Kids, Inc. extending the period of performance through September 30, 2017 for provision of supervised visitation and safe exchange services for victims of domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault, and stalking.

**Purpose of Request:**

On October 24, 2013 (Resolution No. 558-2013), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women for continuation of a Safe Havens project and approved execution of an agreement with Sunflower Kids, Inc. for provision of supervised visitation and monitored exchange services.
