Request

The Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works requests approval of the Professional Services Agreement with EA Partners, PLC for the Design of the West Hickman Salt Barn and Construction Documents.

Reason for Request

The LFUCG currently owns property at the West Hickman WWTP that was formerly a compost pad. This agreement is for the development of a design to convert the pad and install a pre-engineered salt storage facility with a minimum of 12,000 square feet and associated facilities. The firm will be responsible for the development of construction plans, specifications and bid documents necessary for contract award to a general contractor qualified to construct the improvements as designed.
