

Access To Site:

Unless otherwise stated, Endris Engineering will have access to the site for activities necessary for the performance of the services. Endris Engineering will take precautions to minimize the damage due to these activities, but has not included in the fee the cost of restoration of any resulting damage.

Dispute Resolution:

Any claims or disputes made during design, construction or post-construction between the Client and Firm shall be submitted to non-binding mediation. Client and Firm agree to include a similar mediation agreement with all contractors, subconsultants, suppliers and fabricators, thereby providing for mediation as the primary method for dispute resolution between all parties.

Billing & Payments:




