Authorization to dissolve the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Public Parking Corporation. There is no longer a need for the continued existence of the corporation (which has no assets), as there are no garages currently owned or financed by or through it, and the remaining functions of the corporation are carried out by the Lexington and Fayette County Parking Authority ("LexPark"). In the event that there was a future need to finance or refinance a new or existing public parking garage it is anticipated that it would be done through LexPark, LFUCG, or the Public Facilities Corporation, or some combination thereof. There is no budgetary impact. (L1012-17)(O'Mara)
