Agreement between The University of North Florida Training and Service Institute, Inc., d/b/a the Institute of Police Technology and Management, Jacksonville, Florida and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government on behalf of the Division of Police, Lexington, Kentucky,

**FOR**

Providing professional, technical and other services needed in conducting an eighty (80) hour training course entitled "*At-Scene Traffic Crash/Traffic Homicide Investigation*" for a maximum of thirty (30) students.

It is agreed that the Institute of Police Technology and Management will provide the following at Lexington:

1. One instructional program in "*At-Scene Traffic Crash/Traffic Homicide Investigation*"
2. To commence on December 5, 2022 and conclude on December 16, 2022.
3. Instructional materials prepared at the Institute of Police Technology and Management.
4. Trainee materials prepared for dissemination during the course.
5. An appropriate Certificate of Completion for each trainee satisfactorily completing the course.
6. Technical assistance required to prepare, conduct and evaluate the course.
7. Training aids and student reference materials.
8. Making all arrangements for obtaining instructors, preparation of the instructor activities and all other arrangements pertaining to instructor transportation and honoraria.

The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government on behalf of the Division of Police agrees to pay a total sum of twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) to the Institute of Police Technology and Management for conducting this course for a maximum of thirty (30) students. Payment in full will be made within 10 days following completion of the program. Course may be cancelled 30 days prior to start date with no penalty. A 10% cancellation fee will be charged any time thereafter.
