SUBJECT: Amendment to the 2017 Consolidated Plan –
PUBLIC HEARING ON JANUARY 31, 2019

Request: Council authorization to approve and adopt a substantial amendment to the 2017 Annual Action Plan to move funding from one Community Development Block Grant project to another resulting in a net zero change. Community Action Council's grant agreement for the Youth 180 program has been canceled (subtract \$10,000) while the Realtor Community Housing Foundation is in need of additional funds to construct accessible ramps for homeowners experiencing disabilities (add \$10,000).

Purpose of Request: It is proposed that a substantial amendment to the 2017 Annual Action Plan be completed. The purpose of the amendment is to reallocate funding to allow for efficient spending. Funding will be reallocated as follows:

Reduce funding for the following project:

- Community Action Council – Project not completed. Reallocate \$10,000 of unused funds.

Increase funding for the following project:

- Realtor Community Housing Foundation RAMP Program – Allocate \$10,000 to accommodate increased need for accessible dwellings.

Net change is \$0.

In accordance with federal regulations found at 24 CFR Part 91.505 and the amended Citizen Participation Plan approved by Council on September 29, 2016 (Resolution 584-2016), these modifications require a substantial amendment to the Annual Action Plan. **Substantial amendments require opportunities for citizen comment. Therefore, a public hearing will be held in conjunction with the regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, January 31, 2019 at 6:00 pm.**

Cost in this budget year and future budget years: Funds will be reallocated within the existing budgets. There are no additional costs.
