Request

The Division of Water Quality requests approval of a professional engineering services agreement between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) and Banks Engineering, Inc. for the Southland/Wolf Run Stormwater Improvement Project. The value of this service agreement is \$305,000.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this request is to contract with Banks Engineering to complete the necessary engineering services for developing stormwater management solutions in the Southland Drive area. Improvements resulting from those stormwater management solutions will help LFUCG meet the obligations found in Appendix K-2 of the CONSENT DECREE.

Eight (8) firms responded to RFQ 37-2016 issued by the Division of Central Purchasing. A selection board comprised of LFUCG staff from the CAO's office, Council office, Environmental Quality & Public Works Commissioner's Office, Division of Central Purchasing, Division of Engineering, and Division of Water Quality recommends award of this contract to Banks Engineering, Inc.

Project Cost in FY17 and in Future Budget Years

The projected cost of the professional engineering services is \$305,000.00.
