**Request**

The Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works request the approval of a Sole Source Agreement and CNG Vehicle Fueling Station Upgrade Agreement with Clean Energy Corp. for the expansion of the CNG Vehicle Slow Fill System for the Division of Waste Management.


**Purpose of Request**

The current CNG fueling system consist of one single hose fast fill dispenser and 63 slow fill locations. The CNG fleet currently exceeds the number of available slow fill locations and additional CNG vehicles are on order. This project would add an additional 15 slow fill locations to the system. It would also add a defueling station for Fleet Services that would allow the CNG tanks to be safely emptied to allow for maintenance on the trucks CNG systems.
