


As per the Record of Decision for the Newtown Pike Project mitigation efforts the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and LFUCG have developed the Lexington Community Land Trust (LCLT), a non-profit organization, to assist the community displaced by the Project and to promote a positive transition while meeting the overall goal of reestablishing the community affected by the Project. The LCLT is hosting a national conference in October 2015 which will highlight the innovative mitigation efforts made on this Project. The Cabinet and the Federal Highways Administrative support this effort and recognize the need of additional funds for the LCLT to host this conference. FHWA has agreed to sponsor the conference with up to \$25,000 of special Technology and Innovative Deployment funds, with the 20% local match (\$6,250) provided by the Cabinet. The Cabinet has also approved the authorization of up to an additional \$35,000 in federal funds to be matched with Toll Credits for a total of up to \$66,250 in eligible expenses.

The Cabinet recognizes the short timeframe and the need for expenses to be paid by the LCLT prior to conference date. The Cabinet is asking LFUCG to reimburse eligible conference expenses made by the LCLT for the conference in a timely manner and the Cabinet will reimburse LFUCG accordingly.
