Requesting approval of a resolution to enter into Professional Services Agreement with SWAG Sisters Working Against Gun Violence to provide Survivor support assistance. The total amount awarded is \$80,000 in FY2027 and be paid in two stipends in amount of \$40,000.00.

The initial term of agreement is July 7, 2026 and ends June 30, 2027.

This Agreement may be terminated by either party for any reason upon thirty (30) written days' notice to the other party. In the event of termination, the Contractor shall be paid in full for all services performed to the date of such termination in accordance with this Agreement.

Survivor Support is for an organization to provide financial assistance along with other resources to those in Fayette-County area that have been directly impacted by gun violence.

Department needs this action completed to move forward with the selected organization to provide these services. The selected organization will be made publicly available.
