Request Council authorization to correct Resolution No. 195-2015 to reflect that the Urban County Government is not obligated to provide matching funds in the amount of \$257,600 for design of Phases IV, V, And VI of Town Branch Trail under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ)

Program

On April 30, 2015, (Resolution 195-2015), Council approved acceptance of award of federal funds in the amount of \$1,278,000 for the design of Phase IV, V, and VI of Town Branch Trail. The resolution incorrectly stated that the Urban County Government is obligated for provide matching funds in the amount of \$257,600. The 20% required local match for design will be provided by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet through toll credits.
