Professional Services: South Elkhorn Pump Station Odor Control Upgrade

Request

The Division of Water Quality requests approval of a professional engineering services agreement between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) and GRW for the South Elkhorn Pump Station Odor Control Upgrade evaluation. The value of this service agreement is \$72,330.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this request is to contract with GRW for assessment of the existing odor control system at the pump station. The deliverables for this assessment are:

- 1. Evaluate the operational integrity of the existing, 12 year old system.
- 2. Produce a report regarding the existing system and evaluate the feasibility of alternative odor control technologies.
- 3. Once the division and stakeholders have reviewed the report and its findings, a recommendation will be given to GRW so that they can prepare a detailed cost estimate for final design, bidding and construction management services for the recommendation odor control upgrade.

GRW was the only firm that responded to RFP 60-2022 issued by the Division of Central Purchasing. The Division of Water Quality recommends award of this contract to GRW.

Project Cost in FY23 and in Future Budget Years



The FY23 cost of the professional engineering services is \$72,330.00. Future cost for detailed design, bidding and construction management services will be negotiated using the hourly rates contained in the proposal. Future costs will be processed as a change order for approval by Urban County Council.
