SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreement with Hope Center, Inc.

Request: Council authorization to execute an amendment to the agreement with Hope Center, Inc. under the Emergency Solutions Grants Program to extend the Hope Center Street Outreach Agreement period of performance through August 31, 2022.

Purpose of Request: On August 27, 2020 (Resolution No. 395-2020) Council approved an Amendment to the 2019 Annual Action Plan and Hope Center Inc. was provided \$1,178,175 in Emergency Solutions Grant funds from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) for the purpose of operating a street outreach program in the amount of \$275,507 and shelter expenses in the amount of \$902,668 related to preventing, preparing for, and responding to the coronavirus. Hope Center, Inc. has requested a grant extension and to align with the HUD deadline for spending these ESG-CV funds.

The proposed amendment would extend the period of performance through August 31, 2022.
