

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT FOUR (4) GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET, AND TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THESE GRANT APPLICATIONS, WHICH SEEK \$2,175,200 IN FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) PROGRAM FOR THE TOWN BRANCH TRAIL MIDBLOCK CROSSING (\$376,000), MT. TABOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS (\$904,000), MASON HEADLEY MULTIMODAL IMPROVEMENTS (\$295,200), AND FIBER OPTIC CABLE ALONG MAN O' WAR AND VERSAILLES ROAD (\$600,000).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute and submit four (4) Grant Applications, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, and to provide any additional information requested in connection with these Grant Applications, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$2,175,200 Federal funds under the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, for the Town Branch Trail Midblock Crossing (\$376,000), Mt. Tabor Road Improvements (\$904,000), Mason Headley Multimodal Improvements (\$295,200), and Fiber Optic Cable along Man O' War and Versailles Road (\$600,000).

Section 2 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
