SUBJECT: REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET/DIVISION OF MAINTENANCE FOR PROVISION OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE TATES CREEK ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

On June 11, 2009 (Ordinance 92-2009), Council approved the acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for Tate's Creek Road Sidewalk Improvements Project. This project provides for the construction of sidewalks on both sides of the road from Enclave to Dove Run Road. Federal funds are from the federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality Program (CMAQ) allocation.


On July 12, 2011 (Resolution No. 312-2011), Council approved execution of an Amendment to Agreement with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) providing for an increase in the design costs and for right of way acquisition.

On August 30, 2012 (Resolution No. 453-2012), Council approved acceptance of additional federal funds in the amount of \$250,000 and approved additional local match in the amount of \$62,500 for reconstruction of traffic signals along the corridor.

Kentucky Transportation Cabinet/Division of Maintenance has offered the LFUCG an agreement providing the LFUCG with necessary traffic signal equipment at a cost of \$54,033.48. Funds are budgeted as follows:
