SUBJECT: Authorization to Execute an Agreement with Hazen and Sawyer PSC for Design

and Construction Management Services RFP #38-2024 East Hickman Pump

Station Expansion and Rehabilitation Project

Request: Council authorization to execute an Engineering Service Agreement with Hazen and Sawyer PSC for design and construction management services required for the East Hickman Pump Station Expansion and Rehabilitation project. Cost not to exceed \$312,341.

Purpose of Request: On March 21, 2024 (Resolution 150-2024), Council approved a Conditional Commitment Letter to accept an additional award of \$2,780,000 in federal funds under Kentucky Cleaner Water Round 2 for the East Hickman Pump Station Expansion and Rehabilitation Project. RFP-38-2024 solicited written proposals for this design effort. Hazen and Sawyer PSC's proposal was the lowest cost qualified response received. The design will increase pumping capacity, provide force main odor control and improve screening management facilities at the pump station. This project is included in the Consent Decree Remedial Measures Plan (RMP) schedule approved by the Commonwealth and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The project is scheduled to complete construction by December 31, 2026.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$312,341 is the cost in FY25 budget. There are no anticipated costs in future budget years.
