**SUBJECT:** Amendment to Agreement for the Tornado Safe Room at Versailles Road Complex extending Period of Performance through June 30, 2018

**Request:**

Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Tornado Safe Room at Versailles Road Complex, providing for extension of Period of Performance through June 30, 2018

**Purpose of Request:**

On December 5, 2013 (Resolution No. 636-2013), Council approved acceptance of an award of federal funding from the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency federal under FEMA's (Federal Emergency Management Agency) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the **Tornado Safe Room at Versailles Road Complex**. Buildings at this complex are constructed of sheet metal on a concrete slab. Occupants cannot be protected in the event of a severe storm or tornado. This project provided for purchase and installation of a pre-fabricated storm shelter.

On July 1, 2014 (Resolution No. 358-2014), Council approve execution of an Amendment to Agreement extending the Period of Performance through June 30, 2016.

Kentucky Division of Emergency Management has offered LFUCG an extension of this project through June 30, 2018 for project completion.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?**

There is no additional cost in this fiscal year and no costs are anticipated in future budget years.

**Are the funds budgeted?**

All project funds have been budgeted.
