Request: Council authorization to execute an agreement with the Fayette County Commonwealth's Attorney's Office to provide data for reporting on the LFUCG FY22 Street Sales Enforcement Grant award.

Purpose of Request: On June 10, 2021 (Resolution 328-2021) Council approved to submit and accept a grant application to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet for the Street Sales Drug Enforcement grant. The LFUCG Division of the Police was awarded federal funds for FY2022 from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet.
