SUBJECT:

Kentucky Fire Commission Grant Fiscal Year 2017

Request:

Council authorization to accept award from the Kentucky Fire Commission Grant in the amount of \$3,200 for FY 2017 from the State Fire Rescue Training Program, funded under the Kentucky Fire Commission.

Purpose of Request:

The Kentucky Fire Commission has offered a grant in the amount of \$3,200 to the LFUCG Division of Fire and Emergency Services. The grant funds will be used to purchase a Thermal Imaging Camera. These cameras help fire fighters see through smoke, which enables them to find the seat of the fire and/or trapped victims more quickly.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Grant funds for Fiscal Year 2017 total \$3,200 with no local match required. Future years' funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

Are the funds budgeted?

Budget amendment #8094 for Fiscal Year 2017 is in process.
