**SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2026 Transportation Cabinet Traffic Safety Program for the
Lexington Police Department**

Request: Council authorization to accept federal funds of \$225,430 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Office of Highway Safety for participation in the Traffic Safety Program for Fiscal Year 2026. No local match is required.

Purpose of Request: The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Division of Police has been offered a grant of \$225,430 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Office of Highway Safety for participation in the Traffic Safety Program. These federal funds originate from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Highway Safety Standards Branch. The main purpose of these grants is to reduce fatalities on Kentucky roadways, minimize injuries to individuals and property, and to educate the public in ways to do this. The Division of Police will use grant funds for police overtime to detect speeders and other traffic violators.

Cost in this Budget Year and future budget years: \$225,430 is awarded for FY 2026. No matching funds are required. Funding for future budget years is dependent upon availability of grant funding.
