Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY20 (Class B Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Lakeshore Village, Inc. in the amount of \$75,000.00.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of the project is to help improve the quality of water flowing into the lake and West Hickman Watershed, reduce structural flooding and reduce impervious area in the development through pavement reduction or permeable pavement. The project elements include permeable pavement, redirection of downspouts from townhomes to the newly installed green infrastructure systems to reduce or eliminate flooding, and underground storage as needed. Stormwater education will also be provided through a residents' walking / educational tour once installation of BMPs is complete.

Project Cost in FY20 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY2020 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$75,000.00.
