Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of an agreement between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) and Stantec Consulting Services for professional engineering services related to the sanitary sewer Capacity Assurance Program.

Purpose of Request

This contract assists the Division of Water Quality with the obligations of the CONSENT DECREE required Capacity Assurance Program. This is an indefinite services contract for one year with a mutual of up to four annual renewals.

The selected firm is the same firm currently under contract for the sanitary sewer Capacity Assurance Program services and was the only response received for this solicitation of services.

Project Cost in FY18 and in Future Budget Years

This project is an indefinite services contract that is Task Order driven. All Task Orders are negotiated and approved by the Director of Water Quality. The first year Task Order is estimated at \$329,370.
